No matter how long you're with us, we have a range of accommodation options for you.

Homestay accommodation

Experience the British way of life with a homestay – living, eating, socialising and practicing your English with your host outside of the classroom. Homestays are booked through external accommodation agencies, registered with the British Council.

On-campus accommodation during the summer

If you're studying with us during the summer, you can also choose to stay in Reid Hall on campus in Regent's Park, overlooking the surrounding gardens. Living on campus allows you to relax and socialise while being just moments from classes and campus facilities.

Each floor has three communal bathrooms and, while rooms include meal credit to be used in the University's dining outlets, there's also a pantry on each floor with a microwave, kettle and sink.

Course length: Minimum 2 weeks, depending on your individual needs and current level of English

You'll complete monthly progress tests if your course is 4 weeks or longer.



IELTS exam preparation

The International English Language Testing System (IELTS) is a widely recognised English language proficiency test used for academic and immigration purposes. IELTS Academic is typically required for admission to universities in English-speaking countries.

An intensive course combining General English in the mornings with English skills classes in the afternoons – focusing on interaction and communication, putting your skills into practice.

General English plus IELTS

21 hours per week

Designed to develop the English language skills and exam techniques you'll need to be successful in your IELTS exam.

General English classes in the mornings focus on improving your speaking, writing, listening and reading skills and cover grammar structures, formal and informal vocabulary and pronunciation.

In the afternoons, you'll learn helpful exam techniques and how to complete reading, listening, speaking and writing tasks to the best of your ability.

The minimum level required for this course is B1.

Combine General English classes in the mornings with afternoon activities each week

This programme runs from 3 June to 14 September – 15 weeks in total.



Pre-sessional courses

Designed for students who currently hold an offer for a university course. Available at various lengths depending on your level of English and the requirements of your course.



Summer English plus Business Skills

Monday to Thursday 09:15-12:30 and 13:30-15:00
Friday 09:15-12:30
21 hours per week

This course combines General English in the mornings with Business Skills sessions in the afternoons. The morning class covers reading, writing, listening, speaking, grammar, vocabulary and pronunciation, with students placed in class according to their level (B1 – C2).

The afternoon class is a mixed level Business Skills workshop that will help you develop the skills needed to communicate effectively and confidently in the modern workplace. Ideal for anyone at an early stage in their career, preparing for a career change or aiming to find a job in an English speaking workplace.

You'll cover how to succeed with job applications and interviews, effective workplace communication and vocabulary and grammar for business situations. The minimum level required for this course is B1.

Summer English Plus Sightseeing

Monday to Friday 09:15-12:30
Tuesday & Thursday 13:30-16:30
21 hours per week

This course combines General English in the mornings with two afternoon trips per week. The morning class covers reading, writing, listening, speaking, grammar, vocabulary and pronunciation, with students placed in class according to their level (A2 – C2).

In the afternoons, you'll explore famous sights and hidden gems in London – learning about British culture, customs, traditions and history while practising your English skills with fellow students.

If you're with us for longer than 12 weeks, you'll start with Intensive English classes at your level (A2-C2) and, in the last 12 weeks, you'll combine General English in the mornings with Academic English and REPT (Regent's English Proficiency Test) exam preparation in the afternoons.

You'll take two mock exams throughout your time with us and one final exam in your last week. Upon successful completion, you can progress directly to your chosen course, provided you've met the entry requirements.
